

HI-SHINE Shine Spray

An invisible protective layer that keeps latex balloons at full gloss for days, without dust and without dulling.

How to use HI-SHINE

- 01 Protect the floor.** Lay down cardboard or plastic. The spray turns smooth floors such as laminate, tile and wood into an ice rink.
- 02 Inflate first.** Fully inflate the latex balloons with air or helium and tie them off.
- 03 Keep 30 cm distance.** Hold the spray bottle or aerosol roughly 30 centimetres, or 12 inches, from the balloon.
- 04 Mist evenly.** Apply a light, fine mist across the surface. Do not stay on one spot too long or you will get drips and runs. No rubbing or polishing needed.
- 05 Let it dry for 15 to 20 minutes.** The liquid looks milky white straight after spraying and dries completely transparent and glossy.

Still seeing matte or dull patches after about 30 minutes? Go over those spots very lightly once more for a perfectly even finish.

Keep the surroundings clean

HI-SHINE is a professional product based on high quality silicones. Silicones do not dissolve in water and leave stubborn, dark grease marks on walls, facades, backdrops, furniture and clothing.

✗ Never spray directly in front of a wall or facade

✗ Never spray without covering the surroundings

✗ Never install before the balloons are dry

The fine overspray drifts past the balloons and soaks straight into the facade, the brickwork or the plaster. It does not come back out.

THE GOLDEN RULE

Spray in a separate location and let the balloons dry for 20 to 30 minutes before you install.

Have to spray on site? Cover the background, the walls, the floor and everything nearby completely beforehand with a large tarp or sheet.
